KEY DEFINITIONS - ACCESS REQUIREMENTS



Easy –

- Pathways are clear, level, continuous, and accessible pathways from the drop off point to the venue.
- No stairs to navigate
- Wide accessible doorways inside the venue, plenty of lighting and space
- Movable or adjustable seating
- Under 50 meters of walking
- Fully accessible bathrooms
- Low noise



Medium –

- Pathways are clear, although continuous with different surfaces used, may have small inclines, or declines to navigate from the drop off point.
- Up to 3 steps with rails.
- Normal sized doorways inside venue with reasonable lighting and space.
- Movable seating
- 50-100 m walking required
- Accessible bathrooms
- Medium noise



Hard –

- Pathways are a mixture of different surfaces, some being uneven. There is uphill and downhill walking from the drop off point.
- More than 3 stairs and stairs with no rails
- Normal sized doorways, low lightening, limited space to move about
- Fixed seating
- Over 100 m of walking required
- Bathrooms available
- Noisy / busy venue

You will receive an automated message the day before your outing to advise you of your pick-up time. Pickups can start as early as 6.00am. Please be ready on the day and wait inside in case we need to call you. Remember to wear comfortable shoes and bring medications, water, snacks, ID, seniors and concession cards, mobility aids and money for lunch if required.

Our volunteers are only able to provide general support to enter and exit the vehicle and are not able to provide physical assistance under any circumstances. 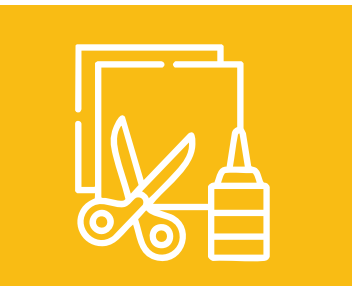

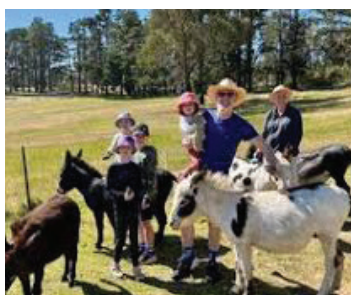
